MATCHFEES for league events are **£5.00 per person, per match.**

TRANSPORT FEES on arranged transport: Competitors travel free of charge; non-competitors travel fee is £5.00 or £18.00 for a family of 4/5.

The bus picks up at Wey Valley School bus stop and Top 'o' Town Car Park.

We always try to arrange bus travel where the distance involved makes it unreasonable and/or uneconomic to use members' own transport. This year we have arranged commercial transport for every SWAL and YAL fixture because it seems to improve attendance. Athletes are encouraged to make use of the club transport because it helps to improve team spirit as well as saving on petrol costs. **Athletes must notify the team manager whether they can or cannot attend a match so that we can book the appropriate size of coach.**

There is always adult supervision on the buses as team managers travel with the team, but families are encouraged to come along and support their athlete.

Car Share. This is sometimes arranged in lieu of commercial transport when only a few athletes are attending a match. You will be notified if the £5 car share charge is in operation for any event.

e.g. Team manager or other club helper has been asked to transport 1+ athletes in his/her own vehicle. All members under 16 must have written parental consent to travel in any private transport driven by any club helper for official club events. This form will be distributed at training.

Please remember that the Club's Welfare Policy applies to all of the fixtures.
